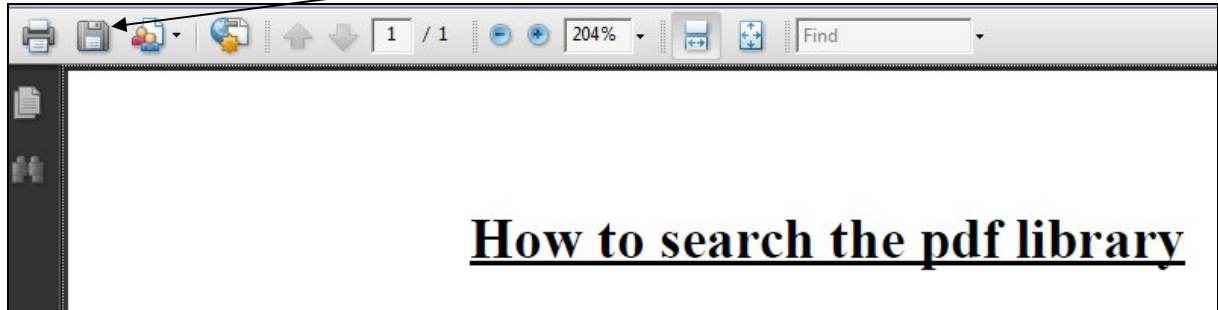
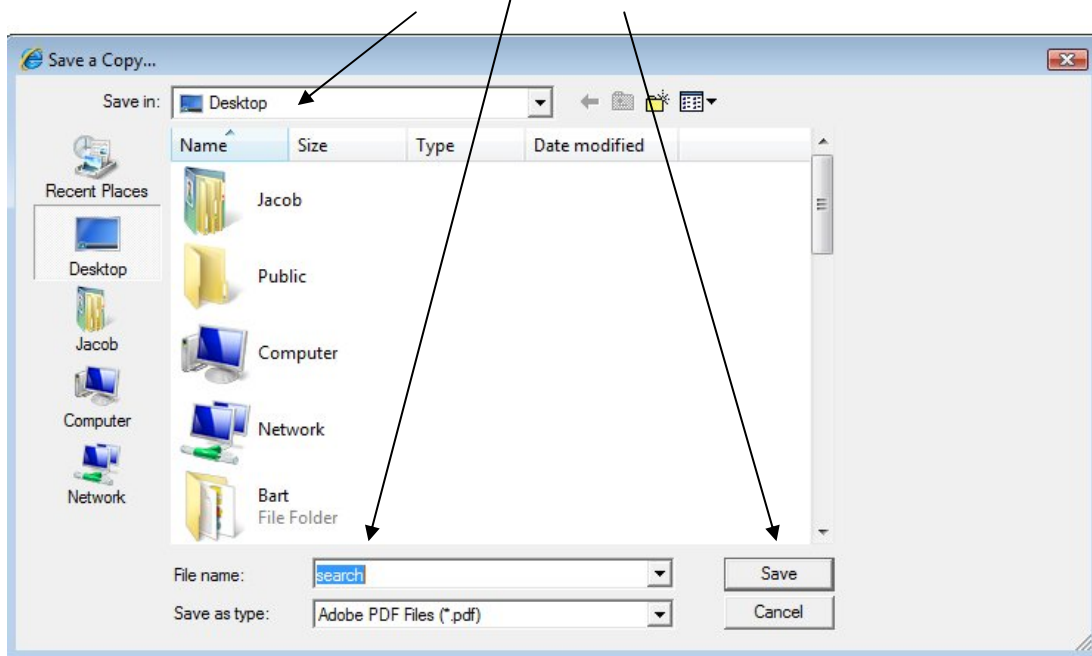


How to search the pdf library

1. Save the file by clicking on the “save” button at the top of the screen.



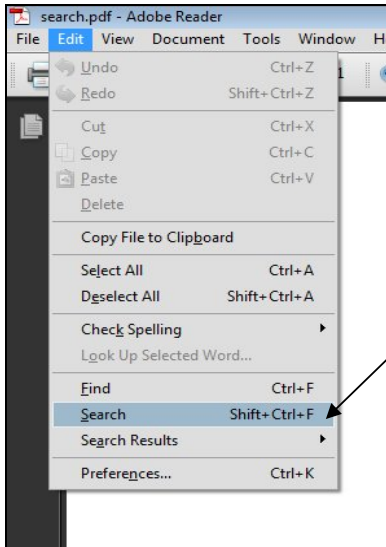
2. Save the file under the name “search” on your “desktop” (or the folder of your choice).



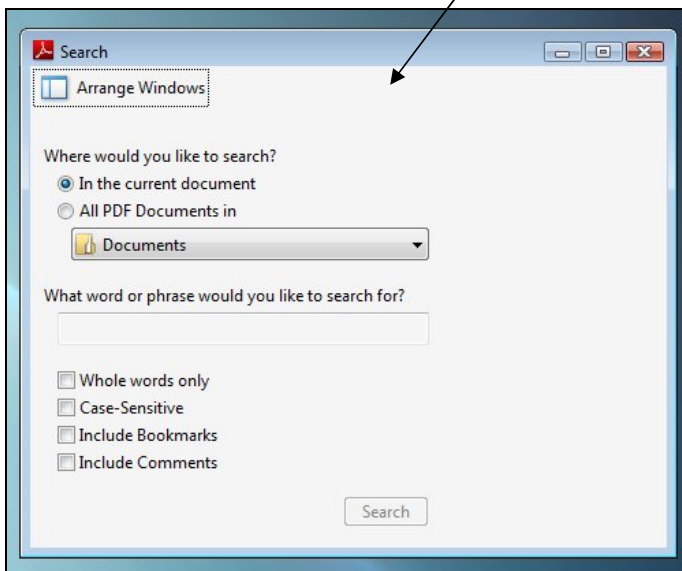
3. Navigate to the file “search”, and open it.



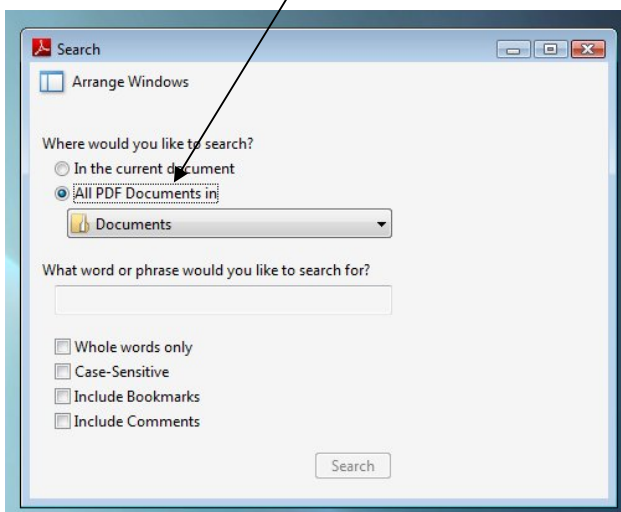
4. At the top of the screen, click on “edit”, and then click on “search” (Alternatively you can press Shift+Ctrl+F at the same time).



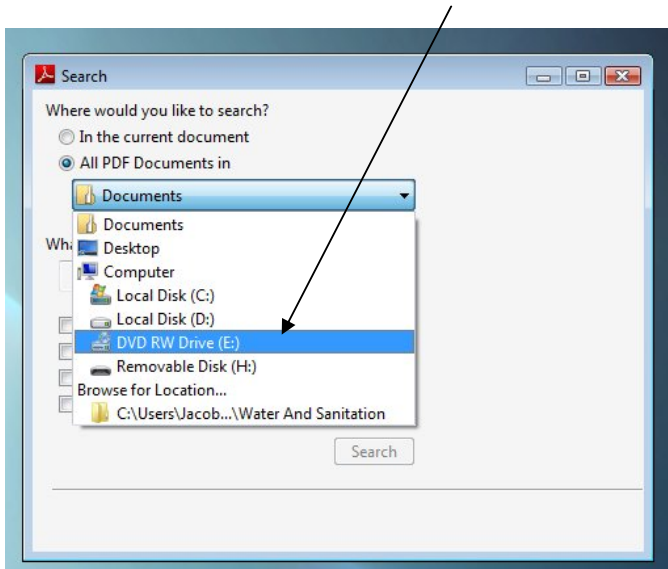
5. This will open the following search box.



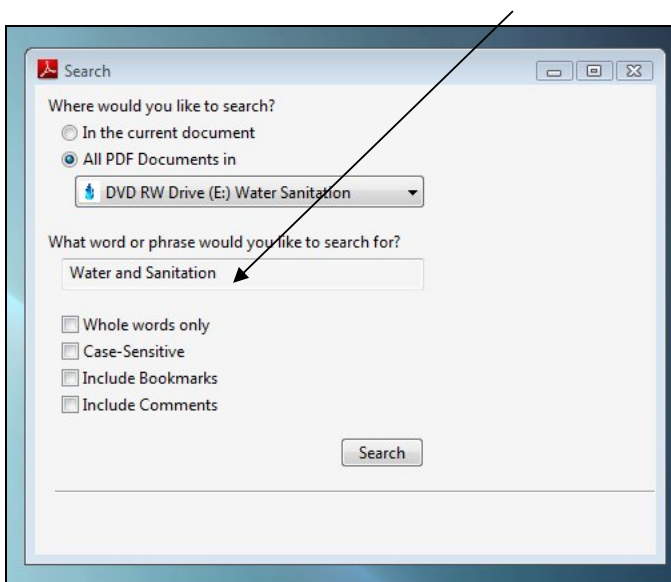
6. Select “All PDF Documents in”.



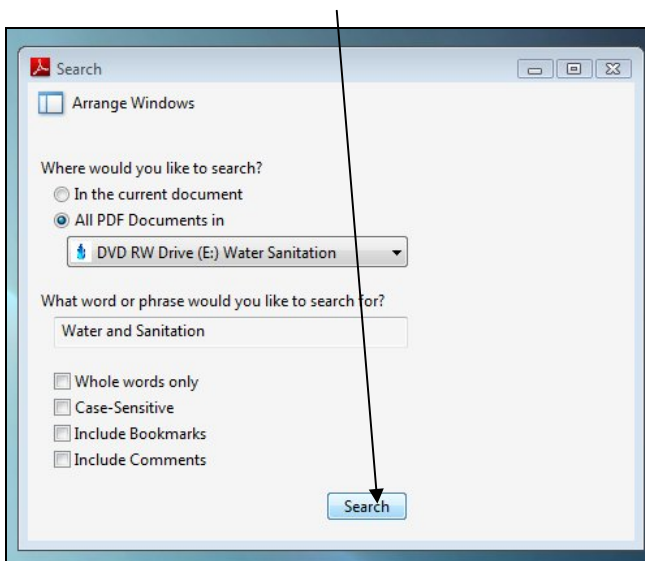
7. From the drop down list select the CD-ROM drive that contains the water and sanitation CD, in this case the drive is E: however yours may be different, so take care.



8. Type in the phrase you would like to search for.



9. Click the search button.



10. This will display a box with all of the results. There are hundreds of documents so searching for phrases, rather than single words, will yield faster searches. To navigate to the paper simply click on the result.
